HEALTH CARE JUST GOT MORE AFFORDABLE

Open Enrollment for 2022 health coverage is here and better than ever. The enrollment period is between <u>November 1, 2021 and January</u> <u>15, 2022</u>. However, if you have a qualifying event throughout the year, you qualify for a special enrollment. This year, thanks to new federal funding, more than 80% of people shopping at CoverME.gov now qualify for financial assistance to help pay for health insurance. Even if you weren't eligible in the past because of your income, it's time to take a second look.

Find a plan with low-monthly premiums and out-of-pocket costs that fits your needs and budget, and get covered for your medical appointments, prescriptions, emergency care, mental health care, substance use treatment and also find a dental plan.

Donating Blood is Essential

About 328 million people currently live in the U.S. Each year, approximately 6.8 million people in the U.S donate blood. Annually, this adds up to about 13.6 million units of whole blood collected for donation in the U.S. The Red Cross provides about 40% of our nation's blood and blood cell components to donors. Your blood donations are used for patients in need of surgery, cancer treatment and transfusions for blood loss from traumatic injuries.

DID YOU KNOW?

NEED HELP PAYING FOR RENT OR UTILITIES?

Downeast Community Partners administers Maine Housing's Rental Assistance Program in Washington and Hancock counties. Applicants must apply on the MaineHousing website.

To apply for benefits, please visit MaineHousing's website, www.mainehousing.org

The program was designed to assist tenants who cannot afford to pay their rent or utilities due to circumstances related to the coronavirus pandemic.

You can apply for this program even if you applied and received funds under the other previous programs.

Under the expansion, renters can apply for up to 18-months of rent and utility aid. This includes retroactive payments spanning from April 2020 to current, plus three-months.
